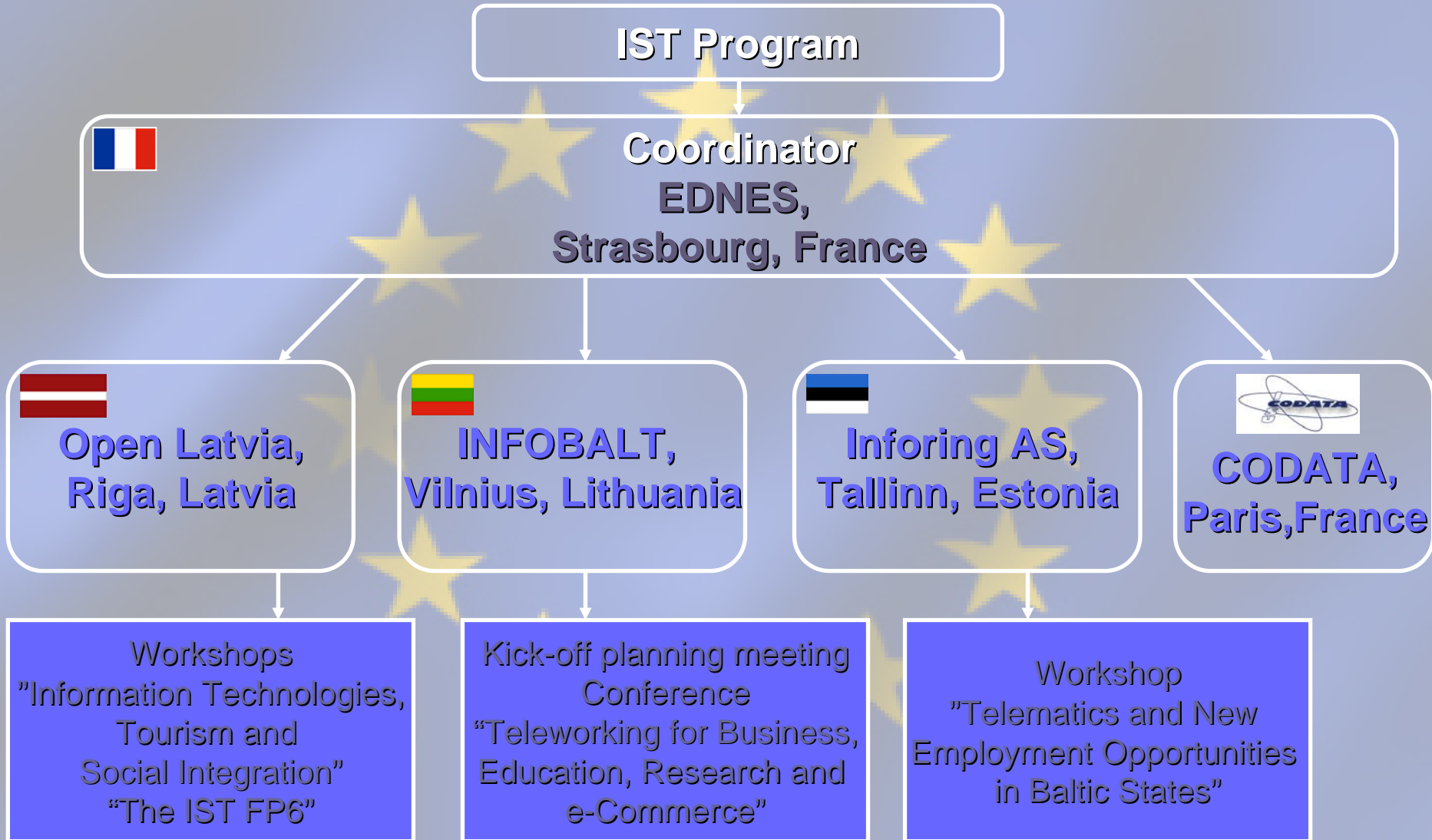


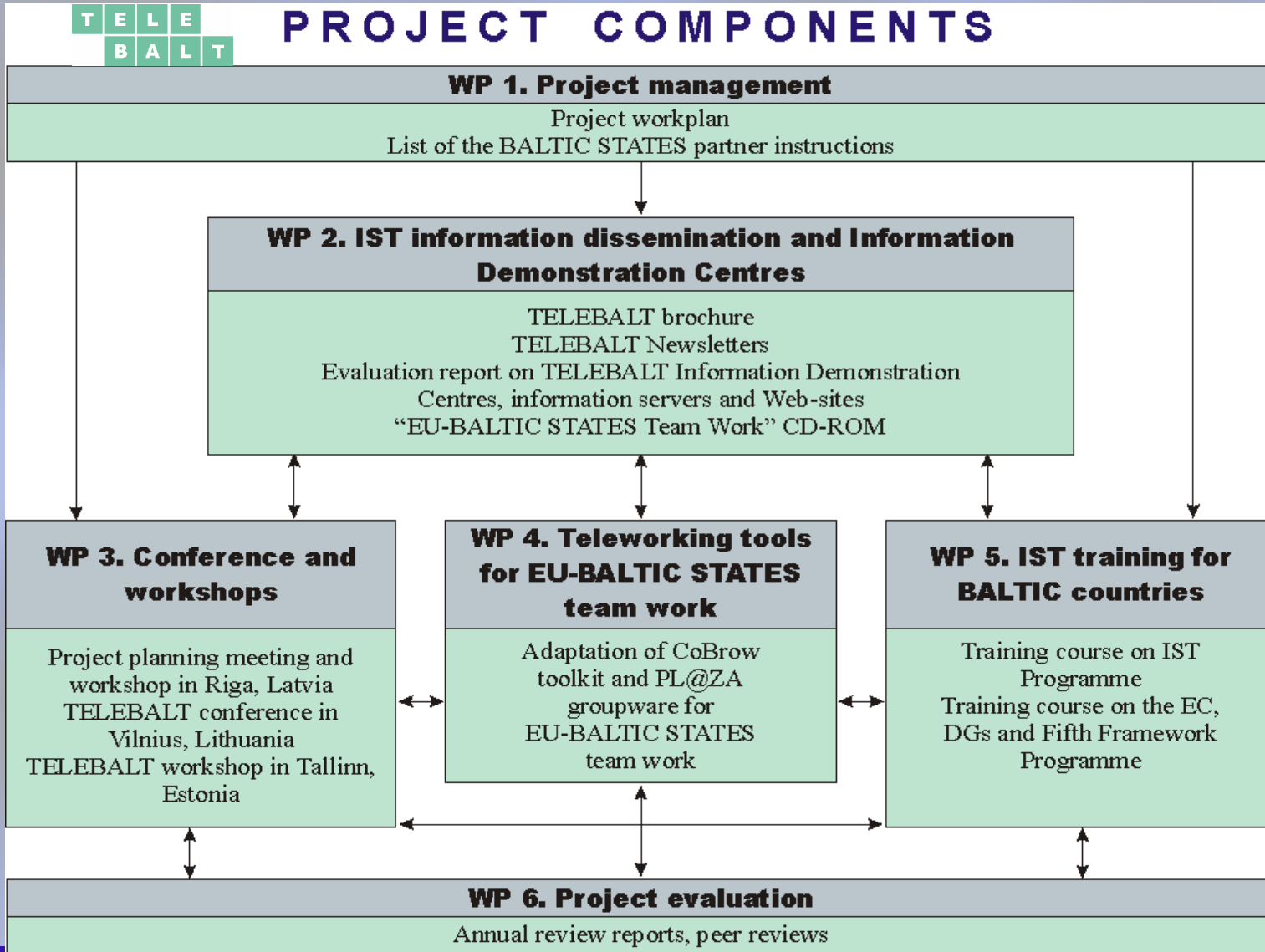
IST4Balt is a multi-partner action that promotes IST innovation activities in the three new EU member Baltic states: Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania

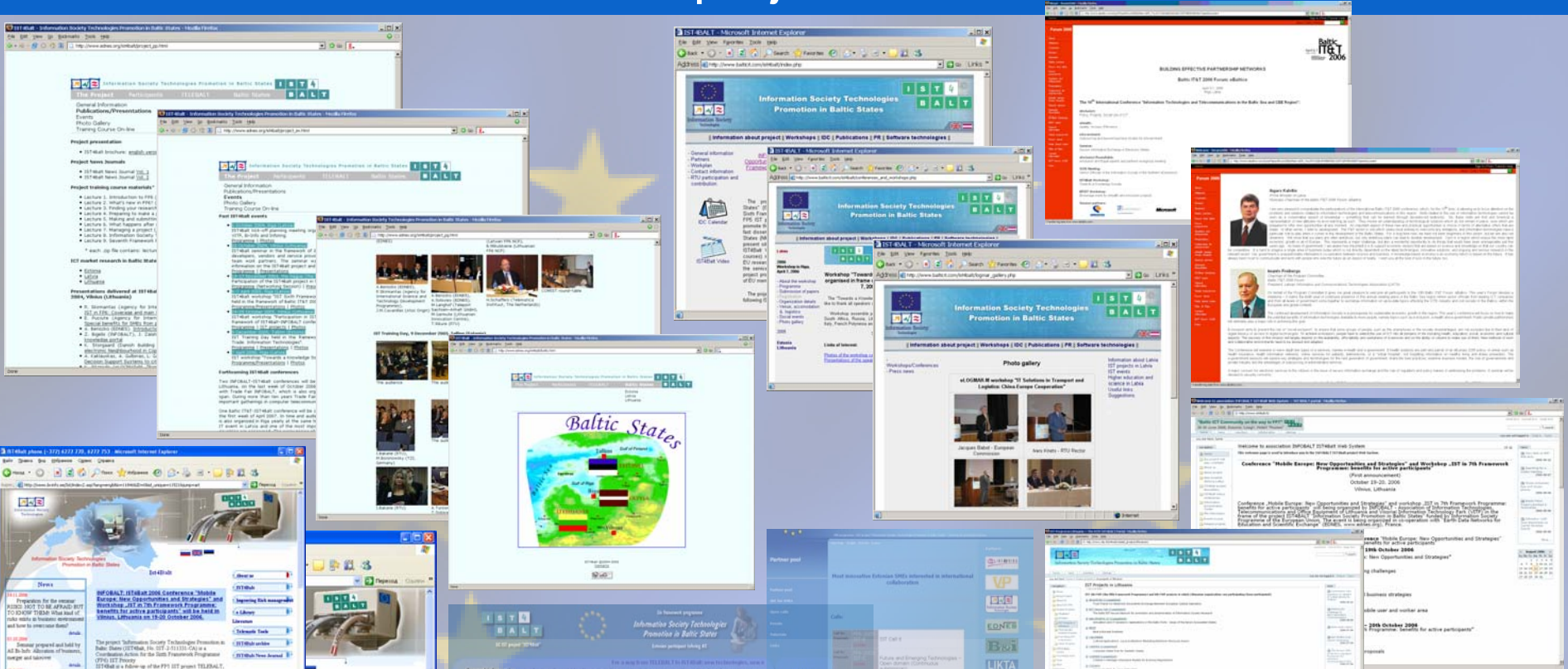
