# 2. The NRC-CISTI Transformation

In February 2009, the Government of Canada performed a strategic review of NRC programs.

- NRC-CISTI publishing (NRC Research Press) transferred to private sector, now: Canadian Science Publishing
- Strategic partnership initiatives pursued with new commitment
  - PubMed Central Canada
  - Research Data Strategy Working Group
  - Trusted Digital Repository
  - Health sector initiatives
- Information discovery and access services refined and streamlined
- New NRC President appointed: John R. McDougall

## **5. The Next Few Years**

Continued development and support of initiatives with focus on:

- Working with other federal science departments and the Canadian health community
  - E.g. new partnership with Health Canada
- Building access vehicles that showcase Canada's research
  - E.g. NRC Publications Archive
- Expanding access to research data
  - Expansion of the Gateway to Scientific Data
  - Continued support of CNC/CODATA



# 5. The Next Few Years (continued)

A Data Strategy Framework and Policy for NRC-CISTI

- Providing dataset management and identity services;
- Improving access to and discovery of scientific datasets;
- Establishing NRC as a government data provider; and
- Sustaining NRC-CISTI's outreach to the Canadian scientific data research community.



# 5. The Next Few Years (continued)

A Data Summit in early 2011

- A consensus around some of the key actions required to develop a national strategy;
- A shared vision of the roles and responsibilities of stakeholders in order to ensure that research data management responsibilities are coordinated and effective; and
- New collaborations and working relationships amongst the various participants of the summit.



- Transformation implementation is a major focus, not yet complete
  Mechanisms and timelines moving forward
- Strategic initiatives and collaborations will be key
- NRC-CISTI remains well-positioned nationally and internationally
- NRC-CISTI has excellent exposure through increased awareness of CNC/CODATA activities
