# eGY recommendations to CODATA

# **Proposed actions by CODATA**

- 1. Pass a resolution supporting eGY.
- 2. Assign eGY responsibilities to a Task/Working Group.
- 3. Appoint a CODATA representative for the eGY Steering Committee.
- 4. CODATA 2006 Conference: include an eGY component and promote the conference as a major eGY symposium event for 2006.
- 5. CODATA 2008 Conference: include an eGY windup event celebrate IGY legacy, review eGY achievements, identify future steps.
- 6. Encourage national CODATA Committees to become active in eGY.
- 7. Engage in establishing a suitable role for eGY for implementing ICSU recommendations arising from the PAA review of data and information.

### **Suggested Task/Working Group activities**

- 1. Liaise with the international eGY community, Secretariat, and eGY Steering Committee and
- 2. Provide feedback and report to CODATA on eGY-related issues.
- 3. Provide feedback from CODATA and report to the main eGY community via eGY News and www.egy.org.
- 4. Make recommendations and proposals to the CODATA Executive and General Assembly about *e*GY matters.
- 5. Play a lead role in chosen eGY theme areas; for example, establishing "eGY" codes of best practice.
- 6. Contribute to developing eGY policy and the eGY Charter.
- 7. Arrange eGY symposia and activities at CODATA 2006 and 2008.
- 8. Arrange specialist workshops and meetings on *e*GY topics of interest to CODATA.
- 9. Use "eGY as a focus for a CODATA outreach program
- 10. Use "eGY as a focus for CODATA capacity building activities, particularly for developing countries.
- 11. Publicise and promote *e*GY within the CODATA community.

#### **Suggested National Committee tasks**

- Identify, promote, and arrange national activities that exploit the eGY opportunity.
- Contribute to CODATA's eGY agenda and the Task/Working Group program.
- □ Link with the international eGY community.
- Contribute to eGY planning and meetings/workshops.
- Provide feedback to members of the national constituency; report in national newsletters, websites, and elsewhere.
- Report to CODATA and to the main eGY community via eGY News and www.egy.org.
- Be an advocate for and publicise eGY.

# Proposed resolution concerning eGY

#### "CODATA,

noting the vast increase in observational data produced since the International Geophysical Year (IGY, 1957-1958), much of them available in near real-time, and the challenges to progress posed by the ever-growing problems of data stewardship, including preservation, maintenance, discovery, release, and ready access,

<u>noting</u> the potential of modern information management methodologies to cope with these limitations through compliance in sharing information and processing capability,

<u>noting</u> the exciting impetus to our understanding of the Earth system that international cooperation in data stewardship offers,

noting the opportunity in 2007-2008 provided by the 50-year anniversary of IGY, which was outstandingly successful in advancing our knowledge of the Earth and geospace through the provision of comprehensive observational data,

noting the attraction of a coordinated approach to addressing the data and information issues that are common to many initives, particularly the ICSU supported "IGY+50" activities such as IPY 2007-2008

<u>supports</u> the adoption of 2007-2008 as the Electronic Geophysical Year (*e*GY) to provide an internationally coordinated framework and focus for a 21st Century approach to information management in the Earth Sciences and beyond.
